€135 million reserved for water technology innovation

The Dutch government has reserved €135 million for the innovation plan of water coalition 'De Blauwe Motor'. Wetsus is one of the architects of the 10-year plan, and is responsible for knowledge development through innovative cooperation between companies and universities. The reserved funds are derived from the National Growth Fund, with which the Dutch government allocates funding to projects which have the highest potential for structural and durable economic growth. In the coming months the water technology innovation plan will be adapted and resubmitted. Final granting of the funds is expected early 2023. If granted, Wetsus and WaterCampus Leeuwarden partners Water Alliance and CEW will be actively involved in the execution of the plan for the coming 10 years.

In the 'Blauwe Motor' coalition, 600 organizations cooperate in securing water availability in an integrated knowledge and innovation program, ranging from research to (new) entrepreneurship, to solve societal challenges and capitalize on economic opportunities.

In person visits back on the calendar!


